Applications are invited for 4 posts of **Assistant Inspector of Drawing and craft works, Government Art Institute, Under the Directorate of Art, Maharashtra Art Education Service, Group -B (Administrative Branch)**

2 RESERVATION FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED PERSONS:

As per G.R. No. apang-2006/(160/06)/आस्था-2, dated 2nd July, 2008, the Physically Challenged Persons amongst Partially sighted/ Low Vision, Partially Deaf / Deaf, One Leg Affected are eligible for the post. However it is noted that there is no reservation for the said post.

3. PAY: 6500-200-10500/- other admissible allowances as per prevalent rules. [Total emolument Approx. Rs.17,000/- per month] **[Likely to be further revised in the Sixth pay Commission]**

4. AGE :

4.1 Not more than **35** years as on **1st July, 2009**. Relaxable as per Rules.

4.2 The upper age limit shall not apply to the employee of Government of Maharashtra

4.3 The age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates possessing exceptional qualification or experience or both

5. QUALIFICATIONS : Candidates must possess.....

5.1 Have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination or an examination recognised as equivalent thereto.

5.2 **(a)** A diploma in Drawing and painting or in Sculpture and Modeling or in Applied art, at least in the second class, awarded by Government;**or**

(b)A degree in Fine Art or in Applied Art at least in the second class, awarded by a statutory university in India;**or**

(c) Any other qualification recognised in this behalf at least in the second class, **and**

(d) An Art Master certificate or diploma at least in the second class, awarded by government, **and**

5.3 Have gained experience, after acquiring the qualification mentioned above in **clause 5.2**, of teaching art in recognised Institutes of Art or in a Statutory University, a recognised Secondary or Higher Secondary School or a recognised Primary Education Training Institute or combined Professional and Teaching experience for not less than Five years.

5.4 Preference may be given to candidates ;

5.4.1 who are acquainted with the techniques of various educational craft, and

5.4.2 who possess a degree of a statutory university in the faculties of art, science, Commerce or education.

5.5 The requirement that the diploma should at least be in the second class may be waived in favour of persons working under the directorate of Art of the Government who were appointed to their respective posts before the date of coming into force of these rules i.e. 1/8/1977.

5.6 If at any stage of selection the Maharashtra Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience or higher basic academic qualification, are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes then, notwithstanding anything contained in clause 5.2 and 5.3, the commission may relax the requirement of class in the degree, diploma or other examinations or the period of experience (to the extent 40%) set out therein and select suitable candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes to fill up such vacancies.

6. DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES : The details regarding duties and responsibilities of the post are available on web site of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission.

7. GENERAL :

7.1 Selected candidates will be on probation for a period of two years.

7.2 In case of non-departmental candidates with exceptionally high qualifications & experience higher starting pay up to 3 advance increments may be granted only if suitably qualified candidates are not available on the minimum of the scale of pay. The extent to which higher starting pay may be granted by Government on merit of each case and higher pay thus granted will remain fixed during the probationary period.

7.3 This post is pensionable as per to G.R. Finance Department No.CPS-1005/126/Ser-4, Date 31st October, 2005 & as per G.R.,CPS-1006/87/Ser-4, dt.12th Jan. 2007.

7.4 A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra

8. NOTES

8.1 The Commission at it's discretion, may shortlist the applicants for interview based on reasonable criteria i.e. experience and/or higher qualification, etc. **OR** may conduct Written objective type screening test (multiple choice question) to shortlist the candidates for interview. The syllabus and medium of question paper and other details for the test shall be displayed on the Commission's Website.

8.2 Copies of certificates should not be attached along with the Application Form. However, candidates are required to furnish an **affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs.100/- to be affirmed before Notary** in respect of correctness and authenticity of the information mentioned in the application form. Specimen of affidavit is published on the Commission's web site in the 'Specimen Form of Affidavit for Direct Recruitment Posts' section.

8.3 The Application Form should be accompanied by an affidavit. Failing which it is treated as incomplete and will be rejected.

8.4 The candidate should submit all the original certificates and one set of zerox copies at the time of interview as per instruction given in chapter-4 of the prospectus provided alongwith the application form
